

## Multimedia Presentation – Bledsoe & Simmerok

- The Office provides a visual representation of a community counseling center and features direct links to each assignment-based “room” in the work environment. Additional features include the Calendar and an instructional video focusing on the course syllabus. The “Get Map” and “Emergency” buttons are designed to assist students who prefer text-based instructions over visual stimuli.
- The Main Classroom offers at-a-glance prompts for each session of the online course. (Note that each room links back to the Office)
- In each Classroom (e.g., Session 3) , assignments are laid out on a whiteboard. The television set links directly to an informational video for that week.
- The Therapy Room provides a photo of counseling situations involving good-looking people. Instructions are provided to clarify the assignments.
- The photo display in the Group Room provides students quick access to helpful hints from former students of the course. When session prompts are clicked, students also access detailed instructions for weekly assignments.
- The Waiting Room provides important links to resources such as the Relaxation Room, informational coffee table, and a Spiritual Room in which students offer prayers, encouraging spiritual comments, etc., to others.
- The functions of the Sakai COURSE LINKS (e.g., Assignments) and COMMUNICATION tools such as Messaging are utilized in much the same manner as in other Sakai courses. Photo-based rooms, such as the Forums Room, provide students additional instructions & videos on how to use these features more effectively.
